Private Events Dress Code

Welcome to the Royal Air Force Club

This guide is here to help you with the Royal Air Force Club's dress code for meetings and events not organised by the Club. It reflects the dignity and tradition of the Club while offering a general overview of what's appropriate to wear when visiting. Please note: some private events may have specific requirements, like Black Tie or Military Dress, which will be highlighted in the event information provided by the organiser.

General guidelines

You'll find the specific dress code rules and guidelines below, but as a general rule, **we ask visitors to the Club to wear smart attire for meetings held in function rooms.**

Permitted and not permitted attire

Your access to the Club is restricted to your event spaces unless prior arrangements have been made to visit other areas, in which case the following rules apply:

Permitted attire: polo shirts, smart trousers, smart tailored shorts, untorn jeans and clean presentable trainers.

Not permitted attire: rubber flipflops, crocs, t shirts, sportswear or gym attire, hooded sweatshirts and overtly branded or slogan-bearing clothing.

Storage of items

Outdoor coats may be left in the self-service cloakroom on the Ground Floor. Small bags may be left with the Hall Porters (space permitting).

Visiting the Club

Your access to the Club is restricted to your meeting spaces. Please do not enter other parts of the Club which are reserved for members only.
